NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE WETLANDS PERMIT**

Description of Permitted Activity: To install maximum six foot high driveway entry gates and untreated wood and/or non-toxic gate posts set 14 feet apart at a pervious stone residential driveway, with access on North Highway (CR 39), within existing disturbed area, located approximately 16 feet from wetlands; to dismantle and fully remove an existing unauthorized treated wood tie retaining wall, on the abutting county owned CR39 shoulder/right-of-way, built within the road shoulder embankment, below unauthorized ornamental privet hedge line, running for a length of approximately 155 linear feet, partially across a pre-existing concrete headwall, and within 6 feet of guardrail and 7 feet of road pavement, as well as within one foot of town regulated freshwater wetlands, to install and stake approximately 20 linear feet of biodegradable untethered coconut fiber and straw biolog, with twine removed, above the concrete headwall and on county land, in order to stabilize the remaining steep disturbed ground, upon retaining wall removal, within one foot of wetlands; to plant remaining disturbed soil and bare erodible ground along the embankment with seedlings of native virginia creeper (*Parthenocissus quinquefolia*) at an approximate density of three (3) feet on center, as well as to allow for natural vegetative germination and succession, inclusive of phragmites colonization, and to remove temporary wood panel boards placed to provide pedestrian access over water and wetlands, upon completion of embankment restoration and successful establishment of planted seedlings and vegetation recovery, with all reclamation measures subject to approval by the Suffolk County Department of Public Works, at existing developed property, with access off Inlet Road and CR 39, in Shinnecock Hills, Town of Southampton, Suffolk County, New York, **in accordance with a survey prepared by Robert A. Smith, dated September 14, 2016, last revised September 22, 2016.**
