**Description of Permitted Activity:** To demolish and remove an existing three bedroom one story residence, with basement and attached garage, with 1248 square feet of first floor living area, located landward of wetlands; to demolish and remove 600 square feet of porch/deck located landward of wetlands; to demolish and remove a driveway and storage shed located landward of wetlands; to abandon an existing septic system, by pumping the system clean, by removing the system, and by backfilling the excavated area, with clean uncontaminated sand, in accordance with Suffolk County Department of Health Services requirements, located landward of wetlands; to disconnect and remove all utilities, including, among others, the existing propane tank, landward of wetlands; to demolish and remove all brick steps, walks and patios; to remove all fences, outdoor carpet, discarded wood, boards, metal, pvc pipe, outdoor furniture, ramps, docks, floats, styrofoam, garden furniture, litter and manmade marine debris; and to install temporary trenched in wire-backed silt barrier, as well as to maintain such barrier until all demolition and land disturbance is complete and any disturbed soils are suitably vegetated and mulched, at existing residentially developed property fronting on North Sea Harbor and containing town regulated tidal wetlands, in North Sea, Town of Southampton, Suffolk County, New York, **as depicted on the survey prepared by Theodore F. Squires dated September 15, 1976.**
