TOWN BOARD RESOLUTION 2017-337

Authorize the Purchase of Playground Equipment for Good Ground Park in Hampton Bays from Town of Islip Contract with American Recreational Products of Bohemia

WHEREAS, the Town of Southampton has been diligent is moving forward with the opening of Good Ground Park; and

WHEREAS, the park grounds are ready to have playground equipment installed and a contract has been identified with American Recreational Products of Bohemia through the Town of Islip; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Town Board Resolution 2014-223, the Town of Southampton is able to piggyback off of any legally applicable agreement that was let in a manner that constitutes competitive bidding consistent with state law and Town of Islip's Contract adheres to these parameters; and

WHEREAS, when goods procured under a valid Cooperative contract exceed the mandatory threshold for goods (i.e. \$20,000), a resolution authorizing the purchase must be submitted and approved by the Town Board; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, per the recommendation of the Parks Director, that the Town Board of the Town of Southampton hereby authorizes the purchase of Playground Equipment for Good Ground Park in Hampton Bays from Town of Islip Contract with American Recreational Products of Bohemia; be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, this contract has been reviewed by Contract Compliance and that the source of funding shall be the Hampton Bays Park Reserve Fund # 4 G/L R3-99-R009-70-6420-7503 in the amount of \$45,000 and the Hampton Bays Recreation Trust Fund G/L R1-99-R021-70-6420-0001 in the amount of \$29,000, subject to the adoption of Town Board Resolution 2017-303.

Financial Impact

The source of funding shall be the Hampton Bays Park Reserve Fund # 4 G/L R3-99-R009-70-6420-7503 in the amount of \$45,000 and the Hampton Bays Recreation Trust Fund G/L R1-99-R021-70-6420-0001 in the amount of \$29,000, subject to the adoption of Town Board Resolution 2017-303.
