Bennett served in the Civil War as a Navy seaman.

On November 6, 1862, James mustered in to service, at the age of 28.

He died on November 25, 1908 and his headstone states he served in the United States Navy on the sloop-of-war USS *Seminole*, the gun ship USS *North Carolina*, and the screw-steamer USS *Pensacola*.

Bennett is buried in Oakland Cemetery, Sag Harbor.

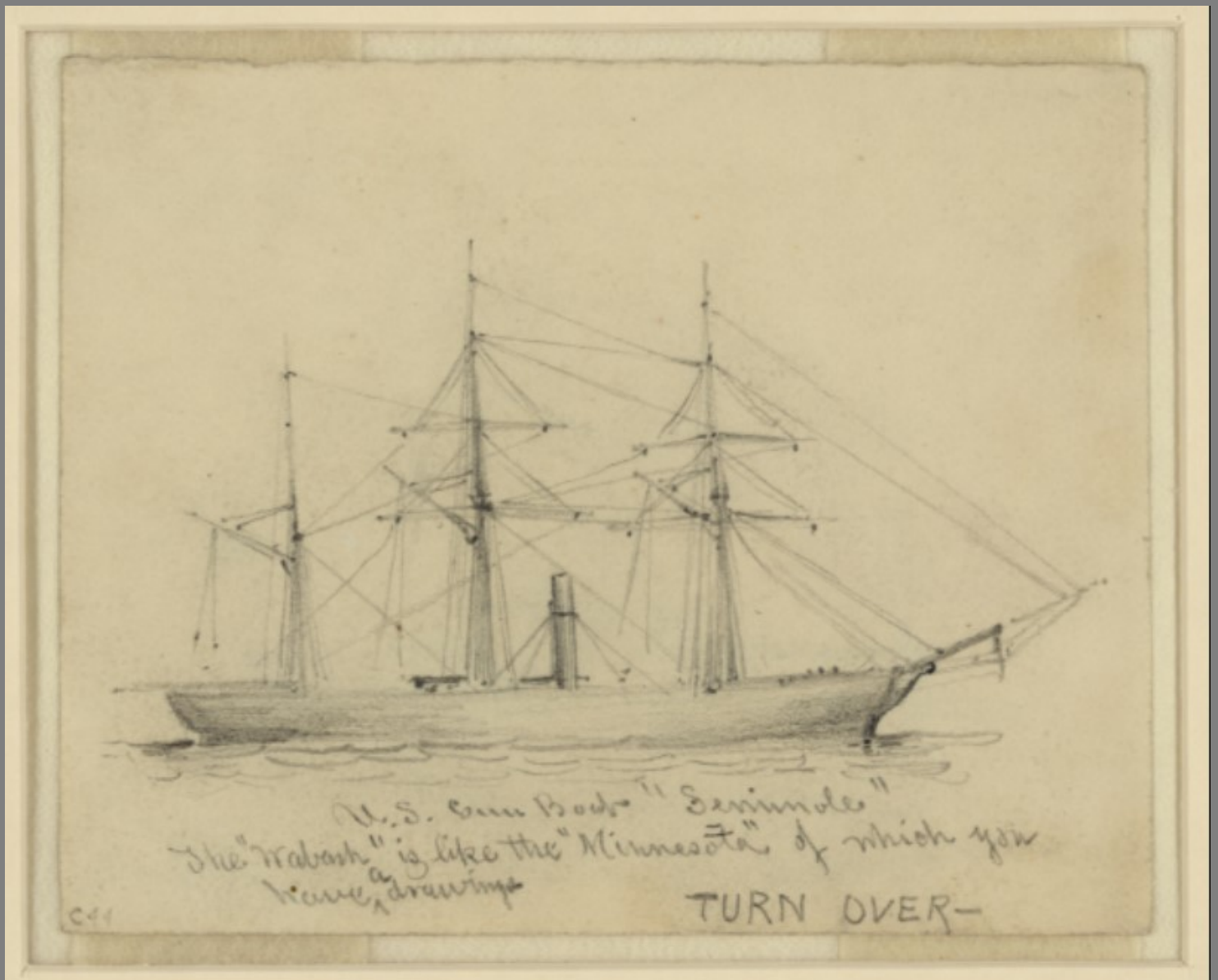

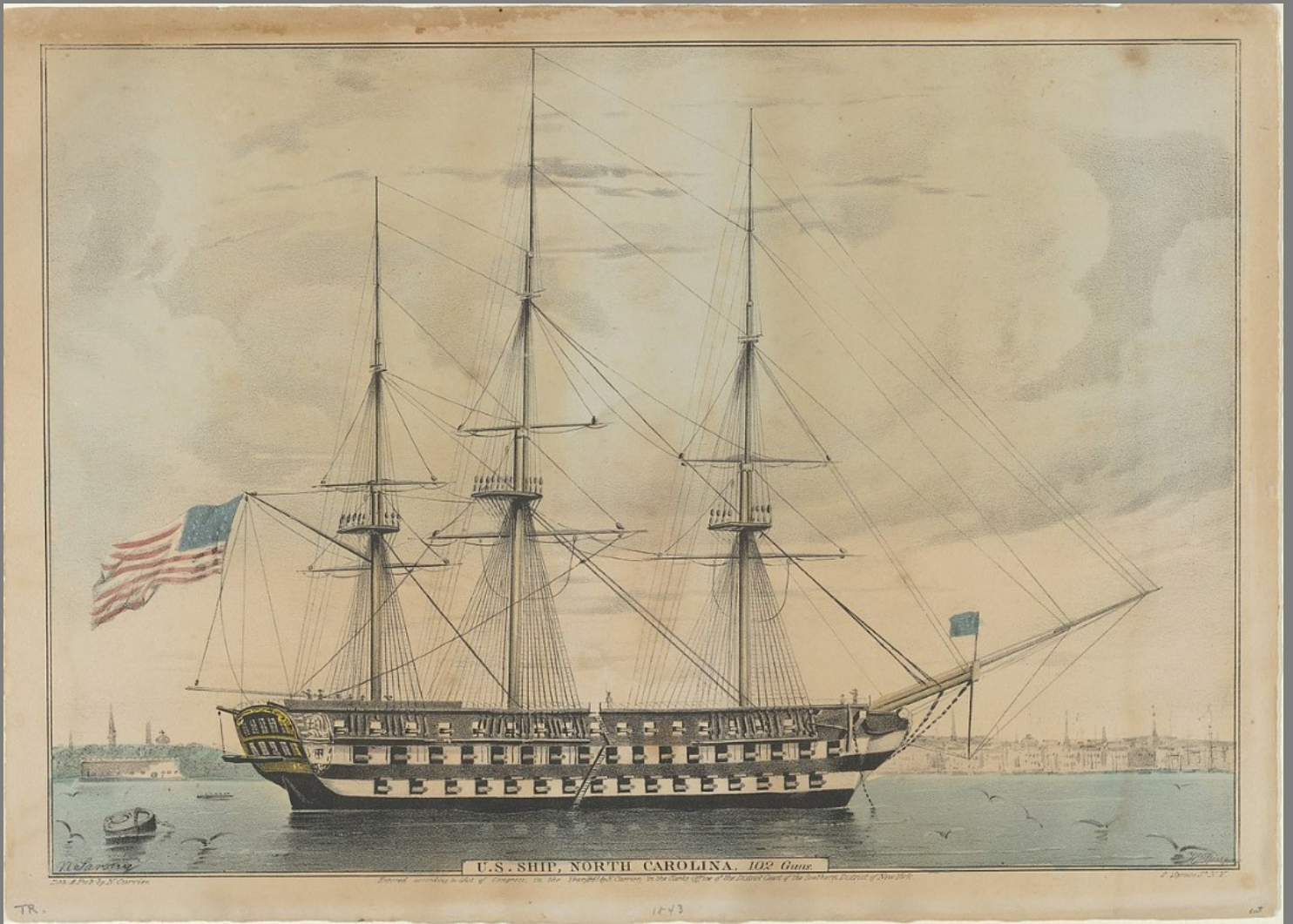


U.S. Gun Boat "Seminole"

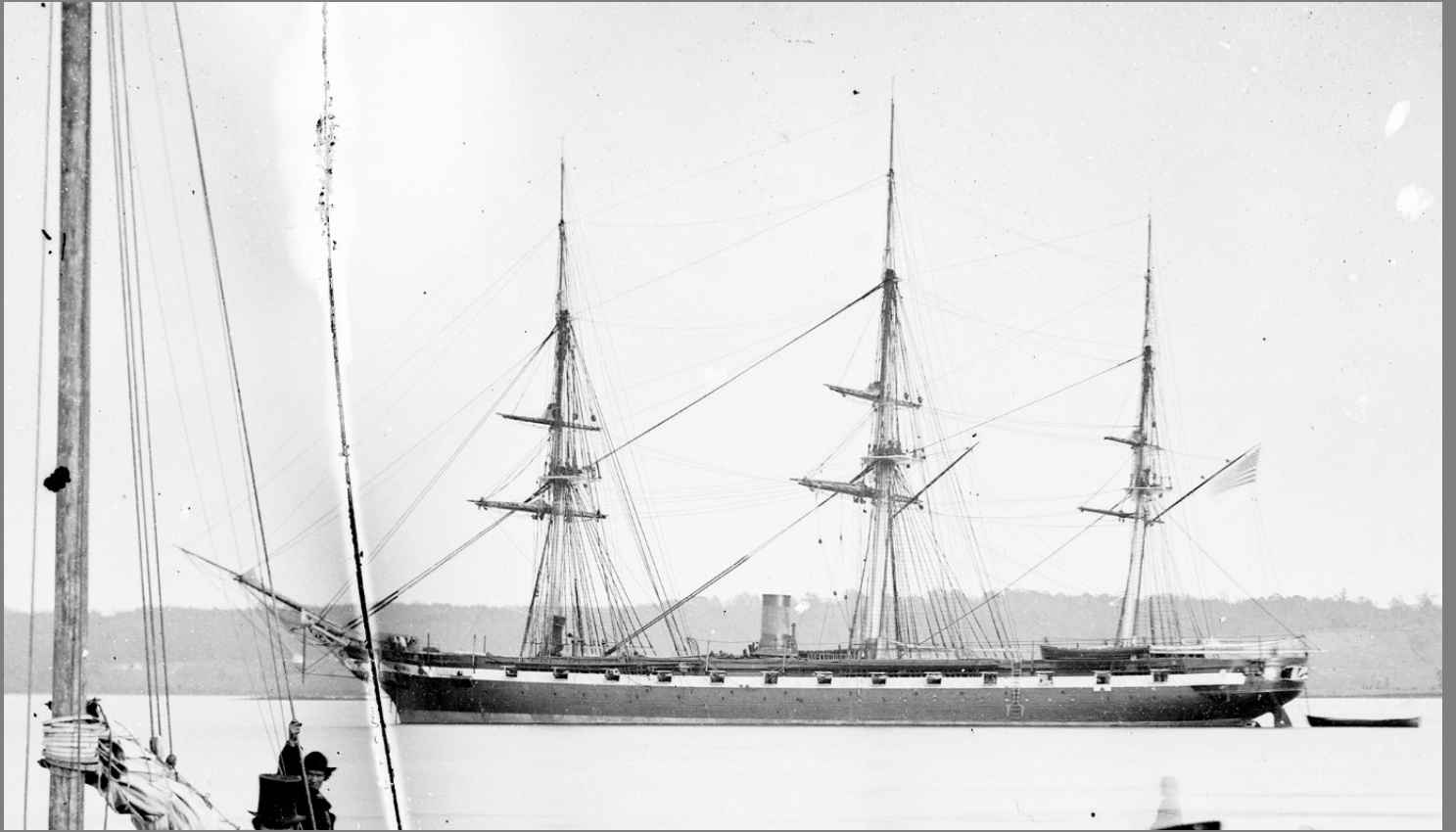
