Hometown: Speonk

Brady served in the 12th Regiment New York Volunteer Infantry, known as the "First Onondaga Regiment," in Company D.

On October 17, 1861, at the age of 20, he mustered in to service and was reported wounded and missing on June 27, 1862, at Gaines Mills, VA. He was later discharged for disability on February 5, 1863, at Convalescent Camp, near Shuter's Hill, Alexandria, VA. (His headstone reads: July 17, 1865).

Brady is buried in the Southampton Cemetery.
