Conklin served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Monitors," in Company K.

On September 8, 1862, at the age of 23, John mustered in with the rank of Private and mustered out in Charleston, S.C., with his company on June 30, 1865.

He is buried in Riverhead Cemetery, Riverhead.
