## William H. Conklin

Hometown: Sag Harbor

Conklin served in in the 48th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the “Continental Guard,” in Company G.

On March 28, 1864, at the age of 17, William mustered in to service with the rank of Private.

Conklin drowned while on furlough on June 18, 1865, from the Steamer Dupont. He is buried in the Oakland Cemetery, Sag Harbor.
