Hometown: Sag Harbor

Conkling served in the 81st New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Mohawk Rangers."

In December 1861, at the age of 18, Henry mustered in with the rank of Private and was later promoted to the rank of Corporal.

He died of fever on October 3, 1864, at the General Hospital in Beaufort, N.C.

He is buried in Oakland Cemetery, Sag Harbor.
