Hometown: Bridgehampton

Corey served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Monitors," in Company K.

On September 8, 1862, at the age of 21, he mustered in with the rank of Sergeant. Corey died of congestive fever on December 1, 1864, at the General Hospital, at Beaufort, S.C.

He is buried in Oakland Cemetery, Sag Harbor.
