Edwards served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Monitors," in Company K.

On September 8, 1862, at the age of 18, he mustered in with the rank of Private. Edwards was discharged June 5, 1863, from the hospital, at Fort Columbus, New York Harbor.

He is buried in Mount Pleasant Cemetery, Center Moriches.
