## Augustus C. Eichel

Hometown: Southampton

Eichel served in the 43rd New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as “Yates’ Rifles,” in Company I.

Eichel mustered in in 1862, at the age of 38, with the rank of Private and was later promoted to Corporal. He was wounded in action at the Battle of the Wilderness, near Fredericksburg, VA. He was injured again, March 25, 1865 and mustered out June 21, 1865, at Washington, D.C.

Eichel is buried in the North Sea Cemetery, Southampton.
