Foster served in the 2nd New York Volunteer Cavalry Regiment, known as
“Harris’ Light Cavalry.”

In September 1862, at the age of 30, he mustered in with the rank
of Private.

Foster was captured and died at Camp Sumter Military Prison at
Andersonville, GA.

He is buried in the Water Mill Cemetery.
