Hometown: Sag Harbor.

Gaffga served in the 165th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as "Smith's Zouaves," in Company C.

In November 1862, he mustered in with the rank of Private. He was wounded in action May 27, 1863 at the Siege of Port Hudson, Louisiana.

He was discharged May 20, 1863, at New Orleans, LA.

He is buried in Oakland Cemetery, Sag Harbor.
