Hometown: Westhampton.

Goodman served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Monitors," in companies D & H.

On September 8, 1862, at the age of 21, he mustered in with the rank of Private.

Goodman was wounded December 6, 1864, at Gregory's Landing, S.C. He was absent on furlough when his company mustered out.

He is buried in the Westhampton Cemetery.
