Griffing served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Monitors," in Company D.

In September 1862, at the age of 19, he mustered in with the rank of Private.

He was captured near Goose Neck, VA., on July 20, 1863. He later died on November 7, 1863, at a hospital in Annapolis, Maryland.

He is memorialized on the Westhampton Cemetery Civil War Monument.
