## Elmer Erastus Halsey

Hometown: Bridgehampton

Halsey served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment,  
known as the "Monitors," in Company K.

On September 8, 1862, at the age of 23, he mustered in with the rank of  
Private and was later promoted to the rank of Corporal.

Halsey was injured but mustered out with Company June 30, 1865, at  
Charleston, S.C.

He is buried in Edgewood Cemetery, Bridgehampton.
