Hildreth served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Monitors," in Company G.

In September 1862, at the age of 20, he mustered in with the rank of Private and was later promoted to the rank of Corporal.

He mustered out with his company June 30, 1865, at Charleston, S.C.

He is buried in the Water Mill Cemetery.
