Howell served in the 81st New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Mohawk Rangers," in Company H.

In October 1861, at the age of 21, he mustered in with the rank of Private. He mustered out December 1864.

He is buried in the Old Bridgehampton Cemetery.
