Jacobs served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Monitors," in Company K.

In September 1862, at the age of 35, he mustered in with the rank of Private and was later promoted to the rank of Corporal. He mustered out with his company on June 30, 1865, at Charleston, S.C.

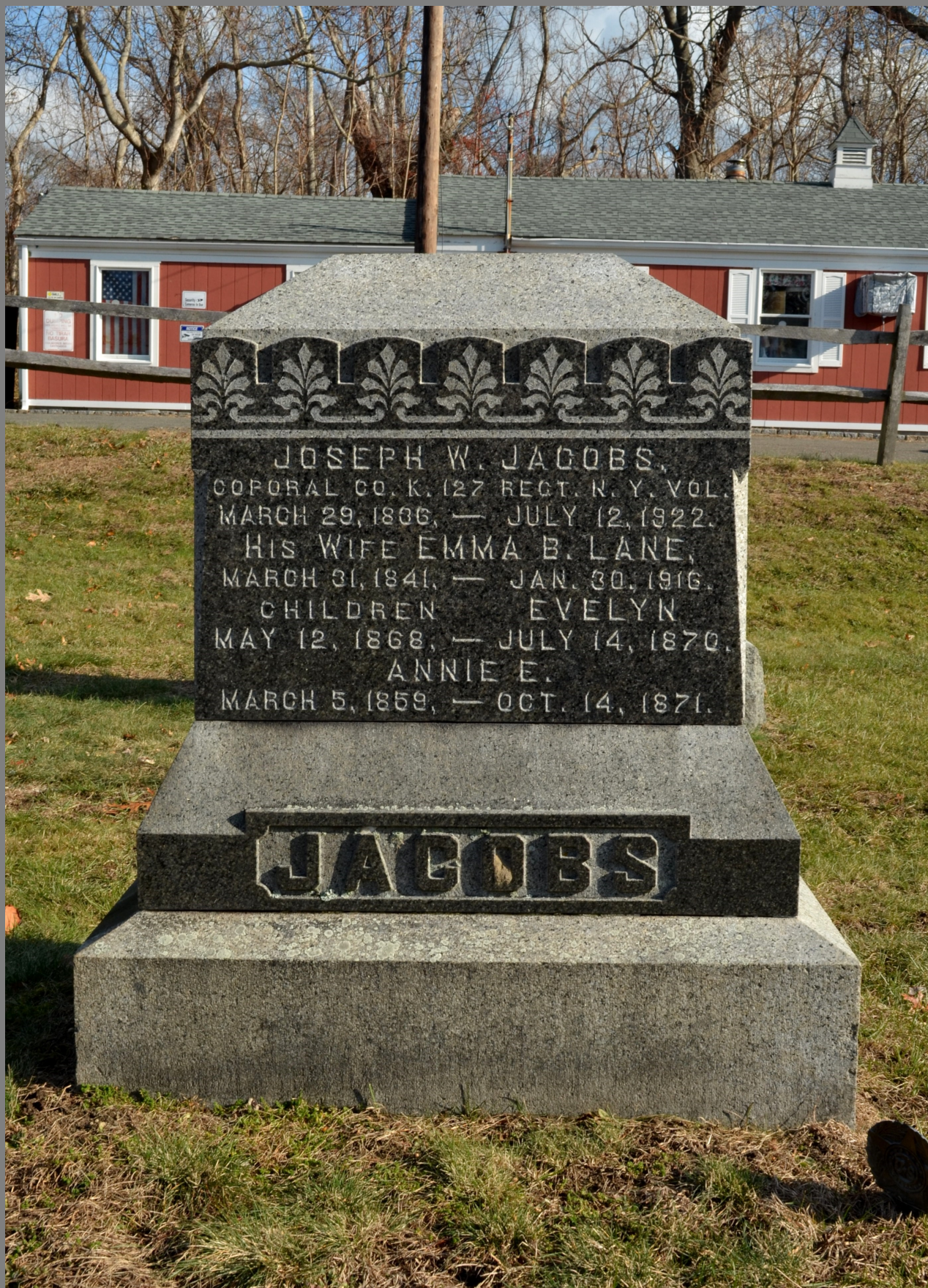
He is buried in the Good Ground Cemetery, Hampton Bays.
