Hometown: Westhampton

Jessup served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Monitors," in Company D.

On September 8, 1862, at the age of 21, he mustered in with the rank of Private.

He was wounded in action, December 6, 1864, at the Battle of Tulifinny at Deveaux's Neck, S.C. He died of his wounds two days later on December 8th, at Deveaux's Neck, S.C.

He is buried in the Westhampton Presbyterian Church Cemetery, Quioque.
