Hometown: Quogue

Moore served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Monitors," in Company K.

In September 1862, at the age of 20, he mustered in with the rank of Private.

Moore was wounded in action at the Battle of Honey Hill, S.C., on November 30, 1864 and mustered out with his company at Charleston, S.C.
