Jeremiah Payne

Hometown: Bridgehampton

Payne served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Monitors," in Company K.

In October 1862, he mustered in with the rank of Private and was later promoted to the rank of Corporal. He died of typhoid fever at Douglass Hospital in Alexandria, VA., August 9, 1863.

He is buried in Water Mill Cemetery.
