Pidgeon served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Monitors," in Company G.

On September 8, 1862, at the age of 33, he mustered in with the rank of Private and was later promoted to the rank of Sergeant.

He mustered out June 30, 1865, at Charleston, S.C.

Pidgeon is buried in Oakland Cemetery, Sag Harbor.
