Alanson Pierson

Hometown: Sag Harbor

Pierson served in the 14th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment; known as the "1st Oneida County Regiment."

He was wounded in the Battle of Antietam, MD. and died of his wounds, October 16, 1862, at a Brooklyn Hospital.

Pierson is buried in Oakland Cemetery, Sag Harbor.



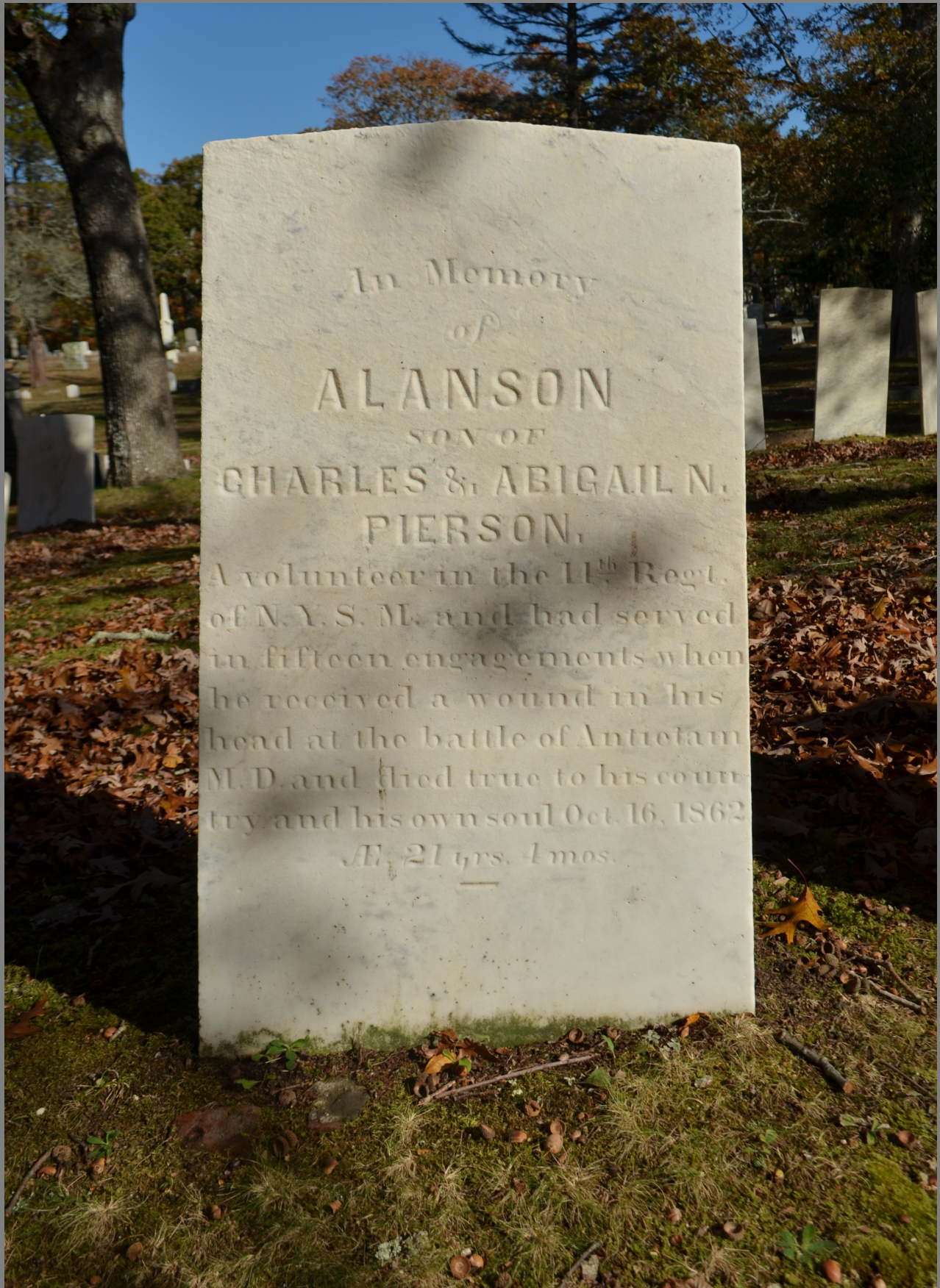
