Post served in the 44th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as
“Ellsworth Avengers.”

In October 1861, at the age of 23, he mustered in with the rank of Private.

Post died on May 18, 1862, in a Brooklyn Hospital. He is buried in the
Southampton Cemetery.
