Rose served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Monitors."

On September 8, 1862, at the age of 21, he mustered in with the rank of Private and was later promoted to the rank of Corporal. He mustered out with his company on June 30, 1865, at Charleston, S.C.

Rose is buried in the Water Mill Cemetery.
