Weed served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Monitors," in Company G.

On September 8, 1862, at the age of 23, he mustered in with the rank of Private and was later promoted to the rank of Corporal. He was wounded and mustered out with his company June 30, 1865 at Charleston, S.C.

Weed is buried in the Water Mill Cemetery.
