White served in the 2nd New York Volunteer Cavalry Regiment, known as the "Harris Light Cavalry," in Company D.

In September 1862, at the age of 30, he mustered in with the rank of Private. He was discharged at the Convalescent Camp, near Shuter's Hill, Alexandria, VA, on February 14, 1863.

White is buried in the Southampton Cemetery.
