Hiram H. Wines

Hometown: Westhampton

Wines served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Monitors," in Company D.

On September 8, 1862, Hiram mustered in to service, at the age of 19, with the rank of Private. He was later promoted to the rank of Corporal. Wines was killed in action on December 6, 1864, during Sherman's March to the Sea in the Battle of Tulifinny, at Deveaux's Neck, S.C.

He is memorialized on the Civil War Monument in the Westhampton Cemetery.
