Hometown: Water Mill

Sayre served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the "Monitors," in Company K.

On September 8, 1862, at the age of 22, he mustered in with the rank of Private. Sayre died at Upton Hill, VA, November 24, 1862.

Sayre is buried in North End Burying Ground, Southampton Village.
