## James Madison Strong

Hometown: Bridgehampton

Strong served in the 127th New York Volunteer Infantry Regiment, known as the “Monitors,” in Company K.

On September 8, 1862, at the age of 26, he mustered in with the rank of Private. He was wounded in action, December 9, 1864, at the Battle of Tulifinny, at Deveaux’s Neck, S.C. He mustered out with his company, June 30, 1865, at Charleston, S.C.

Strong is buried in Cedar Lawn Cemetery, East Hampton.
