

**MINUTES FROM EAST QUOGUE CAC MEETING
FEBRUARY 8, 7PM
VIA ZOOM**

- Karen Kooi called the meeting to order and thanked everyone for joining via Zoom.
- Karen discussed the results of the informal survey. It appears that the majority of people want the area around the flagpole in the park landscaped. Irrigation and drainage of the park was also listed as a priority. If funds are left over, they will go towards Main Street clean up and planting around the tree wells.
- Cyndi will coordinate with Southampton Town on our suggested plans and keep us updated on the progress.
- Debbie said she would reach out to Marissa Bridge, of the Beautification Committee, to ascertain if they plan to do plantings in town, so we are not duplicating efforts and also to see if we could raise funds for beautification of the park.
- Planters/Urns will also be placed on Main Street. Brian Babcock is working on this? (Cyndi will follow up).
- Asputuck Gardens has offered to clean up and plant the welcome signs.
- Cyndi mentioned that Southampton has instituted a program called “Hometown Heroes Program.” People can purchase a banner for a veteran for \$200. They will be placed in Good Ground Park in HB. More information can be found on the Southampton Town website.
- Cyndi will be meeting with the Dark Skies Advisory Committee to review the ongoing light pollution from Deli Delight on Montauk Highway.
- No current updates on the Bridge Petroleum gas station plans.
- Karen mentioned that the parking issue is ongoing at Family Auto. Photos sent to Cyndi.
- Cyndi updated us on the progress of the Bay Avenue Marina. Fencing is now installed. Construction of a pergola will begin in the spring.
