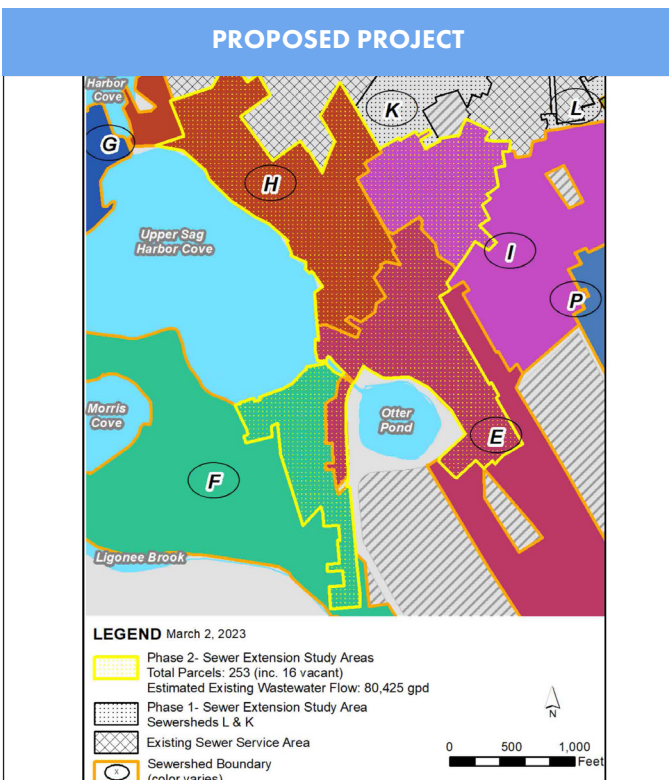

DESCRIPTION:

The Phase II Sewershed Expansion project looks to collect and convey approximately 65,000 GPD of sanitary waste to the existing Village of Sag Harbor Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF). The parcels serviced in the Phase II expansion area include parcels surrounding the eastern side of Upper Sag Harbor Cove and the area around Otter Pond. This includes a portion of sewershed E, F, H, and I.

The Village of Sag Harbor is requesting funding for the cost of professional engineering services for the right of way (ROW) and parcels, regulatory approvals, and the cost associated with the preparation of contract documents suitable for bidding for Phase II of sewer service expansion. In addition, this application includes funding for utility markouts within the ROW and parcels being served, borings and geotech, map and plan, cost estimates, and project administration (page 15). CPF support will help ready the Village for construction. When complete, the Phase II expansion is estimated to connect 217 parcels to the WWTF which would result in a reduction in nitrogen loading to groundwater by 11,872 pounds per year.
