PROJECT TITLE: Trustee Property Restoration, Head of Penny Pond

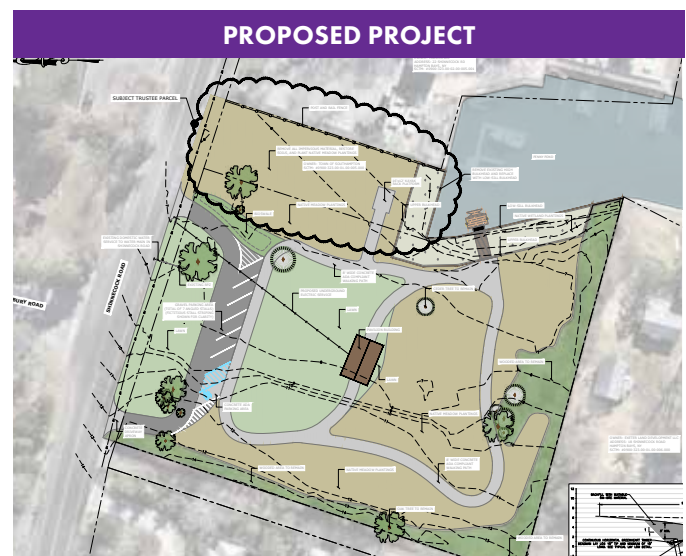

APPROACH: Remediation

DESCRIPTION:

The Southampton Town Trustees are seeking funding to help mitigate stormwater runoff at the head of Penny Pond. The Trustees will construct a vegetated bioswale at the southern end of the property to capture, treat and infiltrate stormwater runoff before entering Penny Pond. The project will also replace approximately 6,200 square feet of impervious material and RCA with topsoil and native meadow plantings. Split rail fencing will be installed along the road frontage and the eastern site boundary to prevent vehicles from entering the site and parking on the meadow. The drainage structure located at the northwest corner of the current parking area will be cleaned and remain in service. The existing bulkhead will be replaced with low-sill bulkhead designed to promote natural interactions between Penny Pond and the shoreline. The design will encourage ecological connectivity, support native habitat and facilitate the establishment of beneficial vegetation to stabilize the shoreline.
