

# **EAST QUOGUE CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING (EQ CAC)**

## **Meeting Minutes**

**October 15, 2025**

**Bay Avenue Marina Building, 6PM**

Cathy Zambetti, Chair, called the meeting to order. Cyndi McNamara, the EQ Town Board Liaison, was in attendance.

### **1. Park District and Village Green Updates :**

Park District approved and finalized - money is in the budget for next year.

Village Green: Accessible playground will be built once flooding issue is addressed. Upon inspection it was discovered that the drainage structure was never installed.

Band shell will be replaced with one that has a sound projecting structure.

Walkway/Track will be replaced

Replacement of all benches was written into the Town budget and will not come out of Park District funds. Discussion of plan for all the plaques in the Village Green. Possibility of a large rock with all the names of everyone who has donated benches, trees, etc. over the years.

### **2. Planning and Zoning Issues:**

Cathy Zambetti reported that there are no new updates on Serenity Fields, Dockers or Bridge Petroleum. No new "Hills" updates, a quick recap was given when a community member inquired.

### **3. Main Street Business Updates:**

**New Moon Café was purchased by Mary's.** GoldBrew still not open, should be very soon, having difficulty with staffing.

### **4. Additional Updates:**

Holiday on Main meeting scheduled for after the CAC meeting - will have an update at the November CAC meeting.

Cyndi mentioned that the Town is considering moving to quarterly CAC meetings.

Grant money that previously went to urns will now go to VFW Vet programs as the urns will be funded through the Park District.

Chief Kiernan of the SHTPD will be making the rounds at the various CAC meetings - will be advised as to when he will be attending an EQ meeting.

### **5. Comments:**

A community member inquired about the possibility of a stop sign at the corner of Walker Avenue and Foster Crossing. The corner is dangerous, too many vehicles, overgrowth of shrubs block sight line and drivers take the turn too quickly which could result in a crash. Cyndi will speak to Charlie McArdle.
