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### Conscience Point Marina: 2026 Lottery Fact Sheet

Information for Town of Southampton resident boat owners requesting dock space.

#### General Information

- Conscience Point Marina has 24 floating dock slips and 44 bulkhead slips.
- Summer contracts run from May 1 through November 15 each year.
- Restroom access and water service may not be available after October 31.
- Maximum vessel length on bulkhead may not exceed 45 feet L.O.A.
- Maximum vessel length on floating dock may not exceed 22 feet L.O.A.
- L.O.A. (length over all) is measured from the farthest point of the bow to the farthest point of the stern, including motor skeg.
- All new leaseholders must be Town of Southampton full-time residents or taxpayers.
- Power and water are available for all bulkhead slips.
- Gas and diesel are available at the marina.
- Public restrooms and garbage collection are available.
- Winter dry-dock storage is available to tenants only.

#### 2026 rental rates:

- \$145.00 per foot for vessels 30 feet L.O.A. or less.
- \$155.00 per foot for vessels 31 feet L.O.A. or more.
- \$200.00 per power hook-up and \$0.30 per KWH over 1,000 KWH.

#### Application Information

- Applications for the waitlist will be accepted by the Town of Southampton Parks & Recreation Department from December 1, 2025 through February 1, 2026.
- If necessary, a lottery will be conducted in February.
- Selected applicants must submit a non-refundable deposit of \$500.00 on or before March 15, 2026 to secure the slip.
- The remaining balance must be paid in full on or before April 15, 2026.
- Amex, MasterCard, Visa, and Discover are accepted. Credit card payments may be subject to a surcharge. Checks should be made payable to: Town of Southampton.
- All applications must include a copy of the boat registration, proof of insurance, and proof of Town of Southampton full-time resident or taxpayer status. Contact the office for acceptable forms of proof.
- A minimum liability insurance policy of at least \$300,000 per occurrence is required at all times while the vessel is docked or stored on Town property.
- The Town of Southampton must be listed as a certificate holder on the insurance policy, and the Town should be notified by the insurance company if the policy is cancelled for any reason.
