Assigned to duty with British forces for instruction in Camouflage work. In February '18 made Camouflage Officer of the 42nd (Rainbow) Division. Spent four months in Lunerville and Baccarat sectors. Took part in General Gouraud's defense of July '14 in Champagne. Our division then relieved the 26th and took part in the advance over the Oure in the Chateau Thierry Sector. Assigned to 28th Div. in the Vosges for 2 weeks. Made Camouflage Officer for the Fifth Corps and as such took part in the St. Michael and Argonne offensive.
