*In training at Valdahon, from arrival in France to early in Mar. Sent to quiet sector east of Verdun and west of St. Mihiel until middle of May. Sent to Chatrau Thierry sector May 31 to support the Marines in their defense against the German drive, and later in their counter attacks.*

*Sent to Soissons, taking part in counter-offensive July 18. Slightly gassed but rejoined regiment at Pont a Mousson, but almost immediately ordered to U.S. to assist in training near Division.*

*Cited for bravery under fire by Major Gen. Omar Bundy, Com. 2nd Div in genl Order No. 48, July 5, 1918.*
