Sailed for France Aug 3, 1917 Served with Norton - Sharps Ambulance unit attached to the French Armies until Nov 21st. Commissioned 2ND Lt. Field Artillery U.S.A. Dec 9, 1917. Trained at Saumur Artillery School and Vincennes Tractor Artillery School until April 1st 1918. Assigned Battery F 15th Field Artillery 2ND Division May 20th. Wounded at Virgny July 21st 1918. Base Hospital #6 Bordeaux until October. General Staff S.O.S. Tours until January 26th 1919. Intelligence Section of General Staff, Paris until discharge.
